

PRIVACY STATEMENT

By accessing our website, you consent to the data collection and use practices described in this privacy statement. These practices may be changed, but any changes will be posted and will only apply to activities and information on a going forward, not retrospective basis.

DATA COLLECTION

We may collect the following information to provide a service or respond to your enquiry or feedback. The personal data that we collect may include:

- name and job title
- demographic information such as postcode, preferences and interests
- other information relevant to your feedback

You are not required to provide this information. However, we may not be able to provide you the requested service or complete your transaction if you choose not to.

We automatically collect certain data about all visitors to our websites, including which pages they view, the links they click, and any other actions taken within our websites. We also collect certain information that your browser sends to every website you visit, such as your Internet Protocol (IP) address, your operating system and browser type, the date and time you access the site, and the website from which you linked to our site. We do not link these data to your identity.

The information that we collect allows us to understand your needs and provide you with a better service, and in particular for the following reasons:

- for internal record keeping in connection with a job application or enquiry
- website improvements
- to periodically send emails about news releases or other information which we think you may find interesting

Each email communication we send includes an unsubscribe link allowing you to stop delivery of email alerts.

COOKIES

This website uses cookies to monitor browsing preferences and help us analyse data about web page traffic in order to make website improvements based on customer needs. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system.

A cookie does not give us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.
